Sir/Madam,

With the present letter, please allow me to take the opportunity to inform you of the recent launch of an initiative of the EU-LAC Foundation's work programme "Explore", the fourth edition of the Foundation's Open Call for research projects related to EU-LAC relations, as foreseen under the Work Plan approved by the Board of Governors in January 2013. Under this call, the Foundation will sponsor individual researchers or research consortia with up to 25.210 Euros in order to carry out investigations on topics of relevance to the biregional partnership. Proposals will be evaluated by the Foundation's Academic Council, an independent body consisting of five renowned academics from both regions who are experts on EU-LAC relations and/or the International Relations, Political Science, and Economics of their respective home region.

The Open Call is launched twice per year, the autumn deadline being set for 30 September and the spring deadline being set for 31 March. The Call is part of the Foundation's effort to fulfil its mandate to "encourage debate [...] for example through publications", *inter alia* through "encouraging studies on issues identified by both regions." Each Call will award one grant.

Let me use this opportunity to assure you of my highest consideration and esteem.
