On the Location

VRBNIK ON THE ISLAND OF KRK

Vrbnik is a small town on the north-east coast of the island of Krk. Naturally separated from mainland Croatia by the Vinodol Channel Vrbnik offers great view of Crikvenica and Novi Vinodolski across the channel. It is known for its rich cultural history, for Croatian Glagolic tradition and its beautiful Mediterranean architecture.

Vrbnik's inhabitants proudly point out that from Vrbnik's surroundings originates the most prominent Croatian noble family – Frankopan, dukes of Krk. In the municipality of Vrbnik the remains of the oldest Frankopan fort, Gradec, are situated. In the town Vrbnik Frankopan's have built Rector's Palace (which isn't preserved in its original form) and Baćin court.

Among the Glagolic written documents created in Vrbnik, Statute of Vrbnik stands out. It was composed in 1388th by the order of dukes Frankopan. It is considered to be one of the most important Croatian medieval legal documents. Vrbnik's glagolic missals from 1456 (First Missal) and 1462 (Second Missal), and several valuable breviary manuscripts are kept in Vrbnik.

Besides town's main beach Zgribnica, Vrbnik has one smaller beach called Pod kovač and Kozica beach, on the eastern edge of town. In undisturbed nature near Vrbnik one can enjoy on the popular white sand beach Potovošće, favoured by Vrbnik inhabitants and tourists.

On the south side of Vrbnik, on both sides of the road leading to Krk town, one can see a vast field of Vrbnik, known for its vineyards. They vineyards produce a specific white wine, called žlahtina. Žlahtina is one of the best Croatian wines. For its quality it is known throughout the world.

It is advisable to book accommodation as soon as possible.

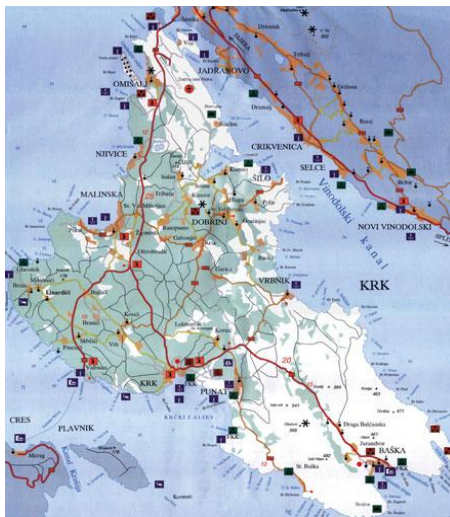

Four bed apartment (two two-bed rooms) costs from 55 to 60 € per day, i.e. 13,75 to 15 € per person (sojourn tax included). That is around 790KN per person for the School's duration.

How to arrive to Vrbnik

To Vrbnik you can arrive by car, bus or airplane.

The Krk bridge links the northern part of the island with the mainland. About 14 buses per day travel between Rijeka and Krk town and two continue to Vrbnik. There are four daily buses from Zagreb (155KN, four to five hours). A local bus line goes twice a day from Krk town to Vrbnik. Airport Rijeka is situated in Omišalj, on the northern part of the island of Krk.
